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The Board of Commissioners recognizes that it is in the best interests of the District residents to establish a policy that clarifies the distinction between residents and non-residents of the District.

These distinctions apply to and govern the fees and charges for all District parks, programs, and facilities.

The Board has determined that:

Resident - means and applies to any person residing permanently within the boundaries of the St. Charles Park District (residing is defined as the actual location of the house structure being located within the boundaries of the St. Charles Park District).

Non-Resident- means and applies to any person residing permanently outside the boundaries of the St. Charles Park District.

Any non-resident that has a portion of his property that is in the St. Charles Park District boundaries (the portion of property located within the District must be contiguous with his residence), may choose one of two options:

1. The amount of taxes paid to the Park District may be deducted from the non-resident program fee. This can be done only once per year; or
2. Annually, pay an amount that equals the Park District's current tax rate multiplied by the net valuation of the parcel on which the house is located. This would entitle the non-resident to all of the benefits afforded a resident.
