Who can apply to be a Counselor in Training?

Ages 12-15 looking to learn and/or advance leadership skills.

Why should I apply?

The CiT Leadership program is a fun and active program where you will build relationships, broaden your coaching skills and gain confidence as a leader.

What does a CiT do?

You will make new friends, participate in team-building games, engage and lead campers in daily activities, participate in field trips and enjoy time at the pool.

What is included in the fee?

Fee includes field trips, supplies for the week, t-shirt AND the opportunity to become a great leader!

How do I apply?

Applications are available online at stcparks.org under 'Forms' on the main page. Complete and submit your application by May 6.

How does the application process work?

All submitted applications will be reviewed and interviews will be scheduled by a Camp Supervisor, and CiT program Counselors.

Does everyone who applies get to be a CiT?

No. The Park District would like to accommodate all applicants, but there are a limited number of spots available. You are not guaranteed a position in the program.

How will I know if I am accepted?

If accepted, you will be contacted by a Camp Supervisor and given instructions on how to complete the registration process in person.

Where do I submit my application?

After completing the form, drop it off in person at the Pottawatomie Community Center, 8 North Avenue or email it to kguizzetti@stcparks.org by May 6. Late applications will not be considered. Interviews will be scheduled throughout May.
